A Ice House

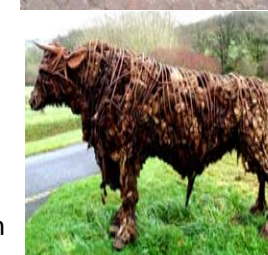
I Echo Spot
